

Education Gaps Program (EGP)

Bungree Education Gaps Program provides an individual and family based service targeting educational, training and employment pathway needs of Indigenous children, youth, families and individuals.

The program works with participants to develop and maintain case management plans that address the specific needs of participants with a focus on educational and employment pathways and where necessary, appropriate access and referrals for health, wellbeing services and other Aboriginal programs and services.

Bungree will liaise with participants and service providers to increase access and participation by:

- Providing outreach and advocacy support
- Assisting with advice and guidance to specialist services e.g. occupational therapy speech therapy, psychological assessments
- Mentoring and assisting parents and carers in their children's learning experiences
- Ensure positive engagement within the school environment for students with a focus on increased participation and attendance in schools
- · Assisting, preparing and supporting participants transitioning into the workforce
- Provide support to participants regarding employment opportunities including cover letters, resume, selection criteria, interview techniques and applications

Target Group:

Indigenous children, youth, families and individuals

Access to Program:

- Self-referrals, schools, various agencies, government and non-government agencies
- Service area covers Central Coast region along with Swansea, Belmont, Toronto, and Morisset areas.
